



USDA to Temporarily Provide Free Breakfast and Lunch for all Oelwein Children 1 to 18 years' old

Starting September 14th, the Oelwein Community School District will be participating in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) that the USDA recently extended. This program is scheduled to run until December 31st OR until funds run out. At this point, no one really knows when this funding may run out, so like everything related to COVID, it will be a fluid process and we will notify families as soon as possible of any changes.

For the time being, this means:

- All Oelwein ages 18 and under will be eligible for free meals (breakfast and lunch)
- We will serve students on-site, at all buildings, during their regular meal times.
- Virtual Learners or opposite day cohorts that are not on-site are still able to pick up meals. **Pre Order form MUST be filled out a day in advance.** The link is on our website under the Back to School tab and will only be active from 11am-Midnight the day before. Pick-up will still be the Southwest doors of the High School cafeteria from 10:30am to 11:00am ONLY.

When funds run out, we will go back to the National School Breakfast and Lunch programs and students will be charged according to their eligibility. If applicable, please make sure to still have a current year free/reduced application on file at the school for this purpose. For now, the free meals will be the only option for school lunch, other than students bringing their own lunch from home.
